



2021 GRECO

The second vintage in the making, our Greco is nothing short of a showstopper. Originally hailing from Campania, we need to turn back the clock to fully appreciate this varietal. This ancient white wine varietal is thought have been in tow when the Greeks came to Southern Italy. Striking in the glass, its brilliant citrine hue exposes a twinkle of malachite at the meniscus. The nose gives way to freshly squeezed lemons, stone fruits like white nectarines and peaches with hints of wet slate and sea mist, whilst flirting with barely ripe tropical fruits like star fruit, kiwi and mango. Downright tangy on the palate, the Greco has an incredibly bright expression with a zippy freshness that immediately harkens images of citrus juice and zest. Upon further pondering, white-petaled flowers like the blossoms of Fuji apples and Yoshino cherries, imbued with myriad lemon and lime flavors from lemongrass and candied meyer lemons to finger limes and silky key lime pie topped with swirls of Italian meringue!

WINEMAKING

Gently whole-cluster pressed, this wine is fermented in stainless steel barrels, with minimal lees stirring and bottled shortly after harvest to capture its enate freshness.

WHO WE ARE

Casino Mine Ranch is an estate vineyard located in the Sierra Foothills of Amador County. The winery — a century old ranch that was once mined for gold — is owned and managed by fourth-generation California brothers, Jim and Rich Merryman.
